## Zhou's Kitchen ★★★★★ **NEW**

Chinese. #01-01 Far East Sq., 7/10 Amoy St., 6877-1123.

This latest establishment by the revered Tung Lok group does not disappoint. Serving first-rate Chinese delicacies



at relatively affordable prices, Zhou's Kitchen is a welcome respite for those who want good food, but do not want to pay astronomical prices. Conveniently located at Far East Square, the vibe here may not be luxe, but who cares when the food is

really that good? We ordered the tasting set menu for two (\$38)—comprising a roast meat platter, fish maw soup, fried coriander balls, eggplant served with spicy Szechuan sauce and minced meat, and mango rolls for dessert—on top individual mains like fried mee sua (\$8) and steamed egg with prawns (\$14). Frankly speaking, everything was really rather good and there was not a single dud in the house. We especially loved the fish maw soup, which was thick, fragrant and one of the best we've ever had, and the eggplant was utterly superb. Our extra orders scored high too—the texture of the mee sua was springy and not soggy in any way, while the steamed egg was silky smooth and excellent. Oh, and service was friendly and top-notch too.
